

SERVING IN THE TRACT DISTRIBUTION MINISTRY

Please share with us what the tracting ministry is about.

The tract distribution ministry is a ministry where we spread the gospel to the residents around our church through distributing gospel tracts. We also invite them to the various evangelistic meetings in our church and share the gospel with them (if they are agreeable). The main point of this ministry is to spread the gospel through the tracts. It is not about the number of people who walk into our church through these tracts or flyers. It is about the salvation of souls through the reading of these tracts.

Tract distribution usually happens every second Sunday of the month (except on the month of the Assembly Gospel Rally). The team members would meet at the basement after lunch. We would catch up with one another as we collect our tracts. After which there would be a short briefing followed by prayer.

We would visit one block of HDB flats nearby. Upon reaching, we would split into smaller groups and begin knocking on the doors of the residents. Whenever the residents open their doors, we would introduce ourselves and pass them a gospel tract and a flyer which contains information about our assembly evangelistic meetings. If no one is at home, we would slip the tract and flyer under their door.

What made you decide to continue with this ministry?

I joined this ministry as it gives me the chance to share the gospel with others. It's a 'it's the least that I can do' mentality. I am not scaling mountains or crossing rivers. I am just passing tracts to people or slipping it under their doors.

What has been a struggle in serving in this ministry?

There is always a struggles with the flesh—laziness, dullness, lack of motivation, self-doubt, etc.

What has been an encouragement for you while serving in this ministry?

The encouragement I received in this ministry comes from seeing faithful brothers and sisters who have served and prayed for this ministry for many years. I am always impressed by their faithfulness to discharge this duty, their courage to knock on the doors despite facing opposition, and their love for the lost.

How can church members pray for this ministry?

Church members can pray for continued liberty in Singapore for us to distribute gospel tracts, and more willing hearts and hands to join in this work. Pray for the spiritual well-being of every member in the team, and that these gospel tracts will convict and convince sinners to repent and turn to the Lord for salvation.

How can church members get involved in this ministry?

This is not a difficult ministry, anyone can get involved. Anyone can just show up at the basement at 1.30 p.m. every second Sunday of the month. Besides joining in the work physically, church members can also be involved by praying for this ministry. I also hope church members would follow up on the leads we encounter along the way. At times, there would be residents who would like to find out more about the gospel or would like to join us in our church meetings or activities, but we are unable to follow up with them due to time constraints. It would be good if some church members are willing and able to follow up with them.
